## POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR TUBAL/ESSURE REVERSAL

- 1. It is not uncommon to experience some vaginal bleeding after the procedure. Please use pads rather than tampons for this postoperative bleeding for the first week.
- 2. If you have problems with constipation, it is okay to take an over the counter laxative. A Fleets enema may be used after the second post-operative day if no bowel function has occurred.
- 3. If a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees occurs, please call the office.
- 4. Do NOT drive while you are taking any narcotic pain medication.
- 5. You may shower the day after your surgery. Only pat the incision dry, do not rub.
- 6. Avoid any heavy food consumption or carbonated drinks until bowel functions have returned to normal.
- 7. Please do NOT exercise until at least 2 weeks following surgery.
- 8. Do NOT engage in sexual activity/intercourse for FOUR (4) FULL weeks after surgery.
- 9. Do NOT get pregnant for 3 months following this procedure.
- 10. It may not be mandatory to have a cesarean section if the reversal was secondary to excising the Essure device, but it is highly recommended that a cesarean section be done rather than to undergo risks associated with labor. The increased intrauterine pressure associated with labor may increase the risk of rupture of the uterus.
